

## **CLFHA First “Mixed-Up” Tournament – Sun., Feb. 10th, 9am – 10pm, Talisman Centre**

The main goal of this tournament is for people to have fun and to get to know players from other teams in the leagues. Teams are made up from a “mix-up” of players from various teams and various divisions in the leagues, including some participants from FHAC.

The entry fee will be \$10 per player ... OR \$5 per player if the player brings a food donation(s) to the Food Bank. All proceeds, less any money spent on some “fun” prizes will go towards the Calgary Food Bank. We will have some boxes available for food bank donations. Facility rental time has been provided by CLFHA.

### **Upcoming Indoor Umpiring Certification**

A CLFHA indoor umpiring certification clinic will be run geared towards umpires who are just starting out (i.e. Div. II or Div. III level matches to start). AMY NILSSON and ANITA MASSEY will be the course conductors. This certification will be a CLFHA-certification (not a provincial certification), which means that CLFHA and Provincial certified umpires will get paid.

The clinic will run from 10am – 1pm. The exam will be scheduled from 1pm – 2pm.

As well, those that attended clinics last year did not get an opportunity to write their indoor exams last year or outdoor exams this past spring can write their exams from 1pm – 2pm.

In order for you to achieve your indoor certification you must:

1. Attend the clinic and pass the written exam with a minimum grade of 75%
2. Practical/Field Assessment: You will only need to pass one field assessment. Please let AMY NILSSON and/or ANITA MASSEY know as soon as possible regarding the best date(s) and time for you to be assessed. The earlier we are able to set this date, the easier it is to have an Assessor scheduled. If you would like some coaching before your assessment (and are not currently scheduled for coaching) please let the AMY and/or ANITA know at the clinic and we can arrange to have another certified umpire come out and watch you before your field assessment.

All Certified Indoor Umpires receive \$15.00 per match. If you get certified during the season, you will be paid retroactive to the start of the season, except for the match(es) in which you are being officially assessed.
